Premium Lawn Program Application Schedule

Application #1: Application begins in January-February. (Liquid Application)

This application will provide the first part of your pre-emergent crabgrass control, including the potash that is needed to provide stronger and healthier root growth. Cool season weed control will also be applied to help prevent unsightly weeds.

Application #2: Application begins in March-April. (Liquid Application)

This application will provide the second part of your pre-emergent crabgrass control, including the potash that is needed to provide stronger and healthier root growth. Fertilizer and iron will be added to enhance the color of the turf as it begins to grow. Cool season weed control will also be applied to help prevent unsightly weeds.

Application #3: Application begins in May-June. (Dry Application)

This application will consist of using a dry granular fertilizer that is designed to give a slow release of fertilizer as well as other nutrients throughout the next 6-8 weeks. It will continue to provide slow to medium growth, while at the same time providing outstanding color and richness to your lawn. Weed control will be applied as a spot spray to weeds that may appear throughout the lawn.

Due to the summer's high temperatures and heat index, please water your lawn with 2-3 inches of water per week. (Water for at least 30 minutes three to four days a week on average. Adjustments will need to be made during periods of rainfall or low temperatures to prevent over watering.)

Application #4: Application begins in July-August. (Dry Application)

This application will consist of using a dry granular fertilizer that is designed to give a slow release of fertilizer as well as other nutrients throughout the next 6-8 weeks. It will continue to provide slow to medium growth while at the same time providing outstanding color and richness to your lawn. Weed control will be applied as a spot spray to weeds that may appear throughout the lawn.

Due to the summer's high temperatures and heat index, please water your lawn with 2-3 inches of water per week. (See above instructions.)

Application #5: Application begins in October. (Liquid Application)

This application will be the fall pre-emergent application. It will have the nutrients needed to help your lawn recover from a long growing season. It will also contain potash, which will help repair root damage from this summer's heat and drought. It will help to increase root growth and overall health of the root structure. Weed control will also be added to help prevent annual bluegrass and fall weeds from invading your lawn.

Application #6: Application begins in November. (Lime Application)

This application of lime aids the Turf grass in two ways. First, it helps raise the soil pH and unlock some of the valuable soil nutrients that your lawn needs. A soil that is too acidic can restrict the plant's ability to grow. This results in weakened turf grass that is easily injured during stressful periods such as high heat, drought, and cold winters. The second way that lime helps is by adding nutrients that are found in deficient levels in the soil. Acidic soils are deficient in calcium, and lime provides this needed calcium necessary for restoring overall plant health and providing root stimulation.

It takes time for lime to react to the soil and effectively change the soil pH, usually 3-8 months. Once the pH is balanced, the turf grass will become healthier and better able to withstand environmental stress. Due to acidic soils in Arkansas, an annual lime application is an important part of your complete lawn care program.

*Additional Services Available

Core Aeration

Core Aeration will be offered beginning during the month of May. Core aeration opens up compacted soil and allows oxygen and nutrients to reach the roots. It keeps the root system from being bound and thus increases the overall health and also reduces the need for excessive watering. It can actually save you money by holding the water you are applying instead of allowing it to run off as it does on hard, compacted soils. Core aeration also helps to reduce thatch build up and aids in the decomposition of clippings, resulting in an organic soil base for your lawn.

Dalis grass

Dalis grass must be treated 3 times in succession to achieve control, and therefore must be contracted separately as needed based on measurements of affected areas. It is not included in the cost for this standard schedule of treatment.

Insect and Disease Control

Insect and Disease control of turf may be contracted separately as needed.
